

**【Itinerary Overview】 : Mutianyu Great Wall, Olympic Stadium, (Bird Nest, Water Cube)**

Today, embark on an unforgettable journey to the **Mutianyu** section of the Great Wall, one of the best-preserved and less crowded parts of this world wonder. Located about 1.5 hours from downtown Beijing, Mutianyu is famous for its breathtaking mountain views and beautifully restored watchtowers. You'll take a cable car up and down to save energy and enjoy more time walking along the ancient wall. Soak in the scenery and imagine life as a soldier standing guard centuries ago.

In the afternoon, return to the city and stop for a photo opportunity at the **Olympic Stadium** area, home to the iconic **Bird's Nest** and **Water Cube**. These architectural marvels were built for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and remain symbols of modern China's global presence. While the visit is from the outside, the structures make for striking photos and are a great contrast to the historical sites seen earlier.



**【 Itinerary Overview 】 : Yuanjiajie Scenic Area, Bailong Elevator, Tianzi Mountain Nature Reserve (Including Round-trip cable car)**

After breakfast, meet your guide and start your full-day adventure in Zhangjiajie National Forest Park.

First, take the world-famous **Bailong Elevator**, a glass elevator built into a cliff, soaring 326 meters high. Enjoy a breathtaking ascent in just a few seconds and take in the spectacular views of the towering sandstone pillars rising from the lush forest below.

Arrive at the **Yuanjajie Scenic Area**, home to the stunning landscape that inspired the floating Hallelujah Mountains in the movie Avatar. Explore iconic viewpoints such as Mihun Stage (Enchanting Terrace), The First Bridge Under Heaven, and Avatar Mountain, where you can capture amazing photos of the dramatic rock formations shaped by millions of years of natural forces.

After lunch at a local restaurant inside the park, continue to the **Tianzi Mountain Nature Reserve** by cable car.
